

ORDINANCE NO. 6249

AN ORDINANCE conditionally approving the Sahalee Sewer District Comprehensive Water System Plan, and declaring an emergency.

PREAMBLE:

The Sahalee Sewer District has adopted a Comprehensive Water System Plan pursuant to Resolution 578 adopted on April 12, 1982, as amended by Resolution 605 adopted on September 27, 1982.

On April 12, 1982, Sahalee Sewer District filed a Final Declaration of Non-Significance for the adoption of a Water Comprehensive Plan.

On September 22, 1982, the Utilities Technical Review Committee recommended conditional approval of the Sahalee Sewer District Comprehensive Water System Plan.

On December 20, 1982 the King County Council reviewed and concurred with the Utilities Technical Review Committee "Report and Recommendation to the King County Executive and Council on the Sahalee Sewer District Comprehensive Plan," dated November 3, 1982.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. "A Comprehensive Water System Plan for the Sahalee Sewer District" as adopted and amended by District Resolution No. 605 is hereby approved, subject to the conditions of Sections 2 and 3 of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. This approval is conditioned by the following:

A. As required by KCC 13.24.060.C., any additional source capacity beyond existing water system capacity is not approved.

B. Water service provided by the Sahalee Sewer District shall be in accordance with the agreement between Sahalee Sewer District and King County Water and Sewer District No. 82, dated October 22, 1982, attached hereto.

1 SECTION 3. After the adoption of the East Sammamish
 2 Community Plan, King County, through the Utilities Technical
 3 Review Committee (UTRC), will initiate a reexamination of the
 4 Sahalee Sewer District Comprehensive Water System Plan in light
 5 of the provisions of the adopted Community Plan. After such
 6 reexamination, the UTRC may make a recommendation to the County
 7 Council regarding any necessary modifications to the approval of
 8 the Sahalee Sewer District Water System Plan.

9 SECTION 4. The County Council finds as a fact and declares
 10 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary
 11 for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety
 12 or for the support of county government and its existing public
 13 institutions.
