

ORDINANCE NO. 6255

AN ORDINANCE increasing the social card game tax from 10 percent to 11 percent of annual gross receipts and amending Ordinance No. 3640, Section 2 and K.C.C. 12.54.100

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 3640, Section 2 and K.C.C. 12.54.100 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Social Card Room Tax: There is levied upon all persons, associations, and organizations who have been duly licensed to operate social card games under the provision of R.C.W. ~~((9.46.030-(1)-and-(3)))~~ 9.46.030 (1) and (4), a tax ~~((per-year-as-follows))~~ equal to eleven percent of the annual gross receipts exceeding ten thousand dollars;

~~((A--One-thousand-dollars-for-the-operations-of-such-card-games; plus B--An-amount-equal-to-((ten))-twenty-percent-of-the-annual-gross-receipts exceeding-ten-thousand-dollars;))~~

PROVIDED THAT no tax shall be imposed when such activities are conducted by any bonafide charitable or nonprofit organization as defined in R.C.W. 9.46.020(3) which organization has no paid operating or management personnel and has gross income from social card games not exceeding twelve hundred and fifty dollars per quarter; PROVIDED FURTHER THAT, the Executive is authorized to implement appropriate fiscal reporting requirements to insure the effective administration of license holders exempt from the payment of taxes.
