AN ORDINANCE concurring with the Recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of JOHN FENTON, designated Building and Land Development File No. 256-81-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the September 22, 1982 report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, filed with the Clerk of the Council on October 7, 1982 on the application of JOHN FENTON to reclassify certain property described in Building and Land Development File No. 256-81-R.

SECTION 2. The recommendation by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to reclassify the subject property from SR 7200 to RMHP-P, subject to conditions is hereby adopted by the Council of King County with the following added condition:

5. No building permit shall be issued for the site until funding is approved for widening Southeast 208th Street from the Benson Highway to 116th Avenue Southeast.

Those conditions which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied on or before June 30, 1983, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect.
