ORDINANCE NO. 6306

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$113,000 from additional Current Expense Fund revenue to the Prosecuting Attorney's Office for the purpose of expanding the Victim/Witness Program pursuant to SSHB 828 and RCW 7.68, amending Ordinance No. 6213, Section 27.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$113,000 from additional Current Expense Fund revenue to the Prosecuting Attorney's Office. The revenue, collected from convicted offenders, will be deposited in the Current Expense Fund and used to support expansion of the Victim/Witness Program pursuant to SSBH 828, The Crime Victim Compensation Act, and RCW 7.68.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 6213, Section 27, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Prosecuting Attorney (~~\$6,720,670~~) \$6,833,670

Provided that:

In 1983, the cost, including overhead and O&M, of the Victim Assistance Program expansion not exceed revenues received from the state for this program.


Provided further that:

The \$41,000 in 1982 revenues generated by SHB 828 will only be used to fund startup costs and temporary positions whose purpose will be to relieve restitution case backlogs and that this \$41,000 will not be used to fund positions in 1983 which will require current expense subsidy in 1984.

PASSED this 31st day of January, 1983.


