AN ORDINANCE approving Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District Comprehensive Water Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On November 19, 1982, Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District (NELWS & WD) filed a Proposed Declaration of Non-Significance for the adoption of a Comprehensive Water Plan.

On September 7, 1982 Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District passed Resolution No. 1982-9-5 adopting the district's 1982 Comprehensive Water Plan.

On November 4, 1982, Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District submitted the adopted Comprehensive Water Plan to King County pursuant to Chapter 57.16 RCW and KCC Chapter 13.24.

As required by KCC 13.24 the Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC) reviewed the proposed plan and on November 24, 1982 recommended its approval subject to the condition that Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District and Water District 42 construct one or more interties between the Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District 489 pressure zone and the Water District 42 492 pressure zone.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water
