ORDINANCE NO. 6314

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2 AN ORDINANCE concurring with the Recommendation
3 of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending
4 King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as
5 amended, by reclassifying certain property upon
6 the application of CALVIN D. WILSON, designated
7 Building and Land Development File No. 200-83-R.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

10 SECTION 1. This Ordinance adopts and incorporates the
11 findings and conclusions of the January 19, 1983, report of the
12 Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, filed with the Clerk of the
13 Council on February 3, 1983, on the application of CALVIN D.
14 WILSON to reclassify certain property described in Building and
15 Land Development File No. 200-83-R.

16 SECTION 2. The recommendation by the Zoning and Subdivision
17 Examiner to reclassify the subject property from SR (Potential
18 BN), SR (Potential RM 900) and SR (9600) to BN (Neighborhood
19 Business), subject to conditions, is hereby adopted by the
20 Council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be
21 satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be
22 satisfied on or before December 31, 1984, or all authority
23 granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall
24 be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date

shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the Building and Land Development Division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
