
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein as its own findings and conclusions the findings and conclusions contained in the report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner dated February 14, 1983, which was filed with the Clerk of the Council on March 3, 1983, to continue on call pending submission and review of surface water run-off analysis and plans upon the application for reclassification from SR to RM 1800, petitioned by MICHAEL A PIERCY and designated by the Building and Land Development Division, Department of Planning and Community Development, File No. 203-83-R. If plans are not submitted prior to December 31, 1984, the application should be denied. The Council does hereby adopt as its action the recommendation contained in said report.


