

ORDINANCE NO. 6403

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the organization
2 of the executive branch of county government,
3 and establishing the position of Jail
4 Commander, Department of Adult Detention,
as a key subordinate position; amending
Ordinance 6066, Section 26, as amended.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1. Ordinance 6066, Section 26, as amended is hereby
7 amended to read as follows:

8 Career Service Exemptions.

9 A. Exemptions from the requirements of the career service
10 personnel system shall be consistent with the provisions of
11 Section 550, and Sections 350.10 and 350.20 of the King County
12 Charter. Key subordinate units, as determined by the County
13 Council, and departmental divisions shall be considered to be
14 executive departments for the purpose of determining the
15 applicability of the Charter provisions.

16 B. Accordingly, directors, managers and supervisors of
17 departments, division, key subordinate units as determined by
18 the County Council, and other units of governments as required
19 by law, shall be exempt from the requirements and provisions of
20 the career service personnel system. In this regard:

21 1. Recognizing the professional nature of the program and
22 the selection process referenced in K.C.C. 2.60, the
23 administrator of the public defense program shall be an exempt
24 position.

25 2. Recognizing the nature of the program and the public
26 policy implications involved, the administrator of the
27 affirmative action program shall be an exempt position; PROVIDED
28 THAT, should personnel presently filling the position have

1 career service status, the position shall not become exempt
2 until a vacancy occurs.


3 3. Recognizing the transitory nature of the program and
4 the public policy implications involved, the administrator of
5 the agriculture program shall be an exempt position.

6 4. Recognizing the nature of the program and the scope of
7 public interest, the Jail Commander, Department of Adult
8 Detention, shall be an exempt position with appointments thereto
9 subject to confirmation by the Council.
