4 ORDINANCE NO. 6511

5 AN ORDINANCE relating to Shoreline Management
6 aquatic resource practices and amending
7 Ordinance 3688, Sections 202, 405, Ordinance
8 4222, Section 1 and KCC 25.08.030, and
9 25.16 .050.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

11 SECTION 1. Ordinance 3688, Section 202, Ordinance 4222,
12 Section 1, and KCC 25.080.030 are hereby amended to read as
13 follows:

14 AQUATIC RESOURCE PRACTICES. "Aquatic Resource Practices"
15 means ~~((the culture or farming of food fish, shellfish, or other aquatic life in fresh or marine waters.))~~ the culture
16 or farming of fin fish, shellfish, algae or other plants or
17 animals in fresh or marine waters.

18 Excluded from the definition of aquatic resource prac-
19 tices are related commercial or industrial uses such as whole-
20 sale or retail sales; or final processing, packing, or
21 freezing.

22 SECTION 2. Ordinance 3688, Section 405 and KCC 25.16.050
23 are hereby amended to read as follows:

24 AQUATIC RESOURCE PRACTICES. Aquatic resource practices may
25 be permitted in the urban environment subject to the general
26 requirements (Section 25.16.030) of this chapter, provided:

27 A. Any structure placed waterward of the ordinary high
28 water mark shall be placed so as not to:

- 29 1. Be a significant hazard to navigation; or
30 2. Cause ~~((or-increase))~~ significant damage to neigh-
31 boring properties; or

1 3. Be a significant hazard to divers who may frequent
2 the area.

3 B. Any byproducts of the ((~~aquaculture~~)) aquatic resources
4 facility which are discharged into the water shall not degrade
5 the quality of the recipient waterbody.


6 C. ((~~Aquaculture~~)) Aquatic resource operations shall not
7 be permitted on Class I beaches ((~~+~~)) except that such opera-
8 tions for the exclusive use and enjoyment of the adjacent
9 upland residential property owner or lessee may be permitted.

10 D. ((~~Aquaculture~~)) Aquatic resource facilities shall be
11 installed with minimum disturbance to banks and ((~~existing~~))
12 channels and shall not cause extensive erosion or accretion
13 along adjacent shorelines.
