

ORDINANCE NO. 6534

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$688,050 to Records and Elections from State reimbursements for the purpose of holding a special primary election on October 11, 1983 as mandated by Senate Bill 4279, signed by Governor John Spellman on September 10, 1983, amending Ordinance No. 6213, Section 26, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$688,050 to Records and Elections from State reimbursements for the purpose of holding a special senatorial primary election on October 11, 1983.

SECTION 2. Since the Washington State Legislature, the Secretary of State, and the Governor have indicated their intent to reimburse local jurisdictions for the total costs of the election, plus administration and overhead, the King County Council appropriates these funds with the intent of receiving reimbursement from the State in 1984.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 6213, Section 26, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Records and Elections ~~-(\$3,267,237)~~ \$3,955,287

SECTION 4. The King County Council finds that the time schedule involved in holding the special primary precludes compliance with normal bidding requirements and, therefore, pursuant to King County Code 4.16.050, waives bidding requirements for printing punchcard ballots for said election.
