ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to King County Charter Section 530 and 960 and Personnel Policy Ordinance No. 4324; adopting new salary levels for managers and elected officials; amending Ordinance 6379, Sections 5 and 6; and repealing Section 16, Ordinance 6142.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The salary allocation list for the following appointed, Career Service and Public Safety position classifications, set forth below, is hereby approved and adopted.

9 PROVIDED THAT, individuals shall not be compensated at the
 10 approved pay range levels prior to the approval, by ordinance,
 11 of the 1984 salary allocation list.

12 SECTION 2. Ordinance 6379, Section 5 is hereby amended to
 13 read as follows:

14 The elected office of the Prosecuting Attorney shall be
 15 compensated at the annual rate of (~~(\$62,502.50-effective-January~~
 16 ~~17-1982)~~ \$65,352 effective January 1, 1984, subject to any
 17 annual adjustment for cost-of-living increases which may be
 18 provided for by a subsequent ordinance.

19 SECTION 3. Ordinance 6379, Section 6 is hereby amended to
 20 read as follows:

21 The elected office of the King County Assessor shall be
 22 compensated at the annual rate of (~~(\$54,167.63-effective-January~~
 23 ~~17-1983)~~ \$59,558 effective January 1, 1984, subject to any
 24 annual adjustment for cost-of-living increases which may be
 25 provided for by a subsequent ordinance.

26 NEW SECTION. SECTION 4. The King County Executive shall be
 27 compensated at the annual rate of \$76,976 effective January 1,
 28 1984, subject to any annual adjustment for cost-of-living
 29 increases which may be provided for by a subsequent ordinance,
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1 and provided that per Section 320.10 of the King County Charter,
2 the compensation of the County Executive shall increase at a
3 rate sufficient to insure that it remains at least one and
4 one-half times the compensation paid to a councilman.

5 NEW SECTION. SECTION 5. As provided for in general law and
6 Section 960 of the King County Charter, elective county council
7 positions shall be compensated at the rate of \$29,500 per year,
8 plus 6% effective January 9, 1978 and increased at the rate of
9 6% per year effective January 1st of each ensuing year (until
10 the compensation provided for in Sections 6, and 7 of this
11 ordinance becomes effective.)

12 NEW SECTION. SECTION 6. Consistent with Article XI Section
13 8 of the Washington State Constitution, RCW 36.40.205 and
14 Section 960 of the King County Charter, effective January 1,
15 1986, elective county council positions for council districts 1,
16 3, 5, 7 and 9 shall be compensated at the rate of \$48,408
17 increased by 6% each year beginning January 1, 1984.

18 NEW SECTION. SECTION 7. Consistent with Article XI Section
19 8 of the Washington State Constitution, RCW 36.40.205 and
20 Section 960 of the King County Charter, effective January 1,
21 1988, elective county council positions for council districts 2,
22 4, 6, and 8 shall be compensated at the rate of \$48,408
23 increased by 6% each year beginning January 1, 1984 so that as
24 of January 1, 1988 and thereafter all nine elective county
25 council positions will be compensated equally.

26 NEW SECTION. SECTION 8. The provisions of a section of this
27 ordinance, so far as they are substantially the same as those of
28 a section of an ordinance existing at the time of their
29 enactment, must be construed as a continuation thereof.

30 NEW SECTION. SECTION 9. Ordinance No. 6142, Section 16, is
31 repealed.
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
1 NEW SECTION. SECTION 10. Should any section, subsection,
2 paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance be
3 declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such
4 decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions
5 of this ordinance.

6 NEW SECTION. SECTION 11. This ordinance shall be effective
7 January 1, 1984.




