

ORDINANCE NO. 6639

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 6551, and concurring with the Recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended by reclassifying certain property upon the application of GRANCO, INC., designated Building and Land Development File No. 118-83-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 6551 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusion of the September 14, 1983 report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, filed with the Clerk of the Council on December 8, 1983 on the application of Granco, Inc. to reclassify certain property described in Building and Land Development File No. 118-83-R.

SECTION 3. The recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to reclassify the subject property from RS 7200 (Potential RD 3600) to RD 3600-P is hereby adopted by the Council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of Council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the Building and Land Development Division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
