

ORDINANCE NO. 6648

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the clean up and sale of wind-damaged timber at Farmers Picnic Park in Enumclaw and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1. High winds over the Christmas weekend in 1983 caused severe wind damage to trees at Farmers Picnic Park.

Section 2. Some of the damaged trees present a hazard and the area needs to be cleaned up immediately.

Section 3. The real property division shall have the authority to immediately contract to have the leaning and downed trees removed and sold and the property at Farmers Picnic Park in Enumclaw cleaned up from damage caused by said winds.

Section 4. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
