

ORDINANCE NO. 6668

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$55,000 from the River Improvement Fund balance to Capital Improvement Project No. 046288, Newport Hills Mudslide to conduct preliminary engineering studies, amending Ordinance No. 6597, Section 77, Attachment No. 1, as amended and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$55,000 from the River Improvement Fund balance to CIP Project No. 046288, Newport Hills Mudslide to conduct preliminary engineering studies to identify remedies to the drainage related mudslide.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 6597, Section 77, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

River and Flood Construction ((\$229,979)) \$284,979

SECTION 3. The project information sheet attached hereto is adopted to amend and revise the 1984 Capital Improvement Budget and Program, amending ordinance No. 6597, Section 77, Attachment No. 1, as amended.
