

ORDINANCE NO. 6674

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County Executive to enter into agreements to transfer Forward Thrust Funds designated for neighborhood parks to the City of Renton, Washington and authorizing the transfer of funds.

PREAMBLE:

The City of Renton owns a watershed known as Springbrook that requires additional buffer land to protect it from adjacent development. This watershed is in an area designated to be served by a Forward Thrust Neighborhood Park per King County Resolution 34571. King County will enter into agreements to transfer \$70,000 to the City of Renton for acquisition and development of a neighborhood park adjacent to the Springbrook watershed consistent with King County Resolution 34571.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with the City of Renton to transfer \$70,000 to develop a neighborhood park designated in King County Resolution 34571 and pursuant to the authority of Section 4 of said Resolution.

SECTION 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to transfer \$70,000 from King County to the City of Renton for such stated purpose as in Section 1.
