

ORDINANCE NO. 6706

AN ORDINANCE relating to the rate of compensation paid to election officials, and repealing Ordinance No. 6533, Section 3.

PREAMBLE:

The King County Council, by adopting Ordinance No. 6533, tied the rate of compensation to be paid to election officials to federal minimum wage for a period to end on March 31, 1984. The Council also requested the Executive to return with a recommended rate of compensation in the first quarter of 1984.

This ordinance repeals the sunset clause contained in Ordinance No. 6533, Section 3, and sets a permanent rate of compensation at the prevailing federal minimum hourly wage.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 6533, Section 3, is repealed.
