

ORDINANCE NO. 6712

AN ORDINANCE relating to the organization of executive branch of county government, and establishing the Court Services Division and Detention Division, Department of Youth Services, and specifying functions; amending Ordinance 6066, Section 18, as amended and K.C.C. 2.16.180.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6066, Section 18, as amended, and K.C.C. 2.16.180 are hereby amended to read as follows:

DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH SERVICES - DUTIES - DIVISIONS

A. The Department is responsible for the management of the services and programs for youth which are mandated by law and/or court rules; and which are defined by the general law provisions of Title 13, RCW, as Juvenile Court Services, which are not the legal or administrative responsibility of another agency. These functions include:

~~1.- Operation of the juvenile detention facility and applicable programs of intake for juvenile defendants and community supervision of juvenile offenders.~~

~~2.- The facilitation of access of alleged dependent youth and "children in conflict" to the judicial process.~~

The department shall be composed of two divisions:

B. COURT SERVICES DIVISION. The principal functions of this division include:

1. Administering intake, placement, probation, rehabilitation services, and related support services, and special supervision programs for delinquent and dependent youth coming under the jurisdiction of the juvenile court.

2. Providing staff support for the King County Juvenile Court for responsibilities related to dependent youth and "children in conflict."

C. DETENTION SERVICES DIVISION. The principal function of this division is to operate the County's juvenile detention facility in a safe, secure, and humane manner as prescribed by state law and court rules. This includes, but is not limited to, administering the social development program and the delivery of services.

1 ((B))D. At the discretion of the King County executive, the department will
2 be additionally responsible for management of supplemental programs which
3 complement the mandated services for youth described above.
