

ORDINANCE NO. 6725

1 AN ORDINANCE approving the consolidation of
2 Summit Sewer District with Kittitas County
3 Sewer District No. 1 subject to a special
election

4 STATEMENT OF FACT:

5 1. A notice of intention proposing the consolidation of
6 Summit Sewer District with Kittitas County Sewer District No. 1
7 was filed with the County Council effective February 2, 1984.

8 2. Summit Sewer District and Kittitas County Sewer District
9 No. 1 have both approved the consolidation agreement as
10 authorized by Summit Sewer District and Kittitas County Sewer
11 District No. 1 Resolution No. 84-1.

12 3. Kittitas County Sewer District No. 1 filed a Declaration
13 of Non-significance dated January 11, 1984, on the proposed
14 consolidation.

15 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 19th
16 day of March, 1984, on the proposed
17 consolidation, and has considered the criteria set forth in
18 R.C.W. 56.02.060.

19 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

20 SECTION 1. The consolidation of Summit Sewer District with
21 Kittitas County Sewer District No. 1, as described in Section 4.
22 herein is approved subject to a special election to be held
23 among the qualified voters of Summit Sewer District and Kittitas
24 County Sewer District No. 1. The special election should be
25 conducted by the Kittitas County Auditor at a date and time to
26 be determined by said Auditor, pursuant to R.C.W. 56-32.040 and
27 .050. Said election shall be conducted in accordance with the
28 general election laws of the state.

1 SECTION 2. The boundaries of the area to be consolidated
2 with Kittitas County Sewer District No. 1 are described as
3 follows:

4 Commencing on the section line at the Northwest corner of
5 Lot 3, Section 4, Township 22 North, Range 11 E.W.M., which
6 is the point of beginning; thence South along the West line
7 of Lot 3 extended to the common boundary of King County and
8 Kittitas County at the summit of the Cascade Range; thence
9 easterly along said county boundary line to the East line of
10 said Section 4; thence North on said line to the North
11 section line of said Section 4; thence west on said section
12 line to the point of beginning, all situate in King County,
13 Washington.

14 Government Lot 4, Section 33, Township 23 North, Range 11
15 East W.M.

16 The Valley Queen Placer Mining Claim Survey No. 303,
17 consisting of the Marmot, Valley Queen and Cellivara Mining
18 Claims; All in Section 33, Township 23 North, Range 11 East
19 W.M.

20 The Mammoth Lode Mining Claiming Survey No. 89, and the
21 Industry Lode Mining Claim Survey No. 86; All in Sections
22 28, 29, 32 and 33, Township 23 North, Range 11 East W.M.

23 The Mammoth Lode Mining Claim Survey No. 46 in Sections 26
24 and 33, Township 23 North, Range 11 East W.M.

25 The Industry Lode Mining Claim Survey No. 50, in Sections 26
26 and 33, Township 23 North, Range 11 East W.M.

27 A portion of Government Lot 7, Section 33, Township 23
28 North, Range 11 East W.M. consisting of a strip of land
29 sixty feet in width the center line of which is described as
30 follows:

31 Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Government Lot 7
32 said Southwest corner being a brass cap monument; thence
33 South 65°51'52" East, 135.56 feet to another brass cap
monument, being the Northwest corner of Government Lot 3 in
Section 4, Township 22 North, Range 11 East W.M.; thence
North 87°54'05" East 335.40 feet to the true point of
beginning on the South line of Government Lot 7; thence
North 3°28'30" East 1.37 feet; thence North 16°12'15"
West, 134.24 feet; thence North 29°49'00" West, 268.28
feet; thence North 43°35'30" West, 82.30 feet; thence
North 20°55'00" West, 57.27 feet; thence North 3°29'00"
East, 280.90 feet; thence North 2°17'45" West, 396.48
feet; thence North 10°46'15" East, 220 feet more or less
to the intersection point with the north line of said
Government Lot 7.

SECTION 3. Completion of this consolidation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any permits, certifications or actions necessary to provide service to this area.
