

ORDINANCE NO. 6735

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$121,107 from local option boat tax revenues to the Department of Public Safety to provide additional marine police patrol operations, and amending Ordinance No. 6597, Section 15, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$121,107 to the department of public safety from local option boat tax revenues for the purpose of providing additional marine police patrol operations.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 6597, Section 15, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:  
Public Safety ((~~\$27,283,830~~)) \$27,404,937

The maximum number of FTE's to be budgeted for Public Safety shall be ((~~653~~)) 656

PROVIDED THAT:

\$165,000 shall be expended on extending the use of 30 police vehicles to 100,000 miles to allow more efficient scheduling of patrol officers.

PROVIDED FURTHER THAT:

A portion of this appropriation may be expended for contracted marine patrol by City of Des Moines for the South Puget Sound-Vashon Island portion of unincorporated King County.
