9 ORDINANCE NO. 6756

10 AN ORDINANCE amending King County Title 21,  
11 as amended, by amending the Zoning Map,  
12 thereof reclassifying certain property  
13 thereon at the request of RICHARD L. BURKE,  
Building and Land Development Division File  
No. 247-78-R.

14 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

15 SECTION 1. RICHARD L. BURKE petitioned on February 17, 1978,  
16 that the property described in Section 3 below be reclassified from  
17 G to S-R, and this application was assigned Building and Land  
18 Development Division File No. 247-78-R.

19 SECTION 2. The report and recommendation of the Building and  
20 Land Development Division was transmitted to the Zoning and Subdiv-  
21 vision Examiner on May 18, 1978, and hearing was held by the  
22 Examiner on May 25, 1978. The report of the Examiner was filed  
23 with the Clerk of the King County Council on June 23, 1978, and the  
24 Council approved the reclassification by Motion No. 03607 on  
25 July 17, 1978, subject to conditions which have now been satisfied.

26 SECTION 3. The legal description of the property to be  
27 reclassified is attached as Appendix A, and is hereby made a part  
28 of this ordinance. The above described property is shown on the  
29 attached map, which is designated Appendix B, and is hereby made a  
30 part of this ordinance.

31 SECTION 4. The King County Council does hereby amend King  
32 County Title 21, as amended, by reclassifying that property  
33 described and shown in Section 3, Appendices A and B above, to

1 S-R, and directs that Area Map W 21-22-6 be modified to so  
2 designate.

3 SECTION 5. This reclassification is granted subject to  
4 conditions adopted in Motion No. 03607, and said conditions are  
5 incorporated herein as though fully set forth herein.
