

ORDINANCE NO. 6771

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to approve 18.75 acres (approximately), subject to conditions of the application for Timberland Designation, petitioned by MICHAEL F. AND MARY M. NIEBUHR, and designated File No. 102-83-S.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein the findings and conclusions contained in the report of the zoning and subdivision examiner dated April 11, 1984, recommending action upon the application of Michael F. and Mary M. Niebuhr for timberland designation described in the building and land development file no. 102-83-S.

SECTION 2. The recommendation of the zoning and subdivision examiner to approve 18.75 acres (approximately), subject to conditions is hereby adopted by the council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the building and land development division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
