

ORDINANCE NO. 6776

AN ORDINANCE conditionally approving the
Water District 119 Revised Water System
Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On December 21, 1982, Water District 119 passed Resolution
No. 143 adopting a Declaration of Non-Significance for the
district's proposed water plan.

On February 7, 1984, Water District 119 passed Resolution
No. 151 adopting the Revised Water System Plan for Water
District 119.

On February 14, 1984, Water District 119 completed its
submittal to King County of an adopted water plan pursuant
to Chapter 57.16 RCW and KCC 13.24.

As required by KCC 13.24, the Utilities Technical Review
Committee (UTRC) reviewed the proposed plan on November 22,
1983 and recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Water District 119 Revised Water System Plan
as adopted by district Resolution No. 143 (attached) is hereby
approved;

PROVIDED, no action toward development of the Moss Lake
storage site may be taken for 18 months from the effective date
of this ordinance. If, during that period, King County acquires
the Moss Lake wetlands, then the Moss Lake storage tank site
shall be deemed not approved; and,

PROVIDED FURTHER, in no instance shall any water main be
permitted to cross or enter the Moss Lake wetlands as delineated
in the King County wetlands inventory.

April, 1984.
