ORDINANCE NO. 6777

AN ORDINANCE approving the Ames Lake Water Association 1983 Comprehensive Water Plan

PREAMBLE:

On September 13, 1983, Ames Lake Water Association, Inc. passed a motion adopting the Associations 1983 Comprehensive Water Plan.

On February 21, 1984, King County filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed plan.

As required by KCC chapter 13.24, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed 1983 Comprehensive Water Plan and on November 22, 1983 recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Ames Lake Water Association, Inc. 1983 Comprehensive Water Plan, dated September 1983, is hereby approved; PROVIDED, that the additional storage proposed in Section 13 may only be constructed if it has the same overflow elevation as storage in Water District 122 (742 feet).
