

ORDINANCE NO. 6784

1 AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning
2 and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution
3 No. 25789, as amended by reclassifying certain property upon the
4 application of STEINMAN AND ASSOCIATES
5 designated Building and Land Development File No. 215-84-R.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and
8 conclusions of the April 20, 1984 report of the zoning and subdivision
9 examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on May 9, 1984 on the
10 application of STEINMAN AND ASSOCIATES to reclassify
11 certain property described in building and land development file no. 215-84-R.

12 SECTION 2. The recommendation by the zoning and subdivision examiner to
13 reclassify the subject property from RS 7200 (Potential RM 2400)
14 to RM 2400-P subject to conditions is hereby adopted by the council
15 of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this
16 ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of council
17 approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this
18 ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date
19 shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective,
20 the building and land development division shall amend the official zoning maps
21 of King County to reflect this action.
