

ORDINANCE NO. 6842

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to approve RM 900-P for lot 12 and deny the remainder upon the application for reclassification petitioned by HERMAN M. ALLENBACH and designated Building and Land Development File No. 208-84-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

This ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein as its own findings and conclusions the findings and conclusions contained in the report of the zoning and subdivision examiner dated February 24, 1984, which was filed with the clerk of the council on March 15, 1984, to approve RM 900-P for lot 12 and deny the remainder upon the application for rezone from RM-1800 and RS-7200 to RM 900 petitioned by Herman M. Allenbach designated by the building and land development division, department of planning and community development, file no. 208-84-R, and the council does hereby adopt as its action the recommendation contained in said report. Those conditions which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect.
