ORDINANCE NO. 6866

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Seattle's 1980 Sewage Collection System Modifications 201 Facility Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On September 29, 1980, the City of Seattle passed Resolution No. 26387, adopting the 1980 Sewage Collection System Modifications 201 Facility Plan.

In September 1979, the City of Seattle filed a Final Declaration of Non-Significance for the Sewage Collection System Modifications Program.

On February 17, 1984, the City of Seattle completed its submittal of the Sewage Collection System Modifications Plan to King County pursuant to RCW 56.08 and KCC 13.24.

As required by KCC 13.24, the Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC) reviewed the proposed plan on March 20, 1984.

The UTRC requested the City of Seattle to supply King County with detailed facilities maps covering those portions of Seattle's sewer service area that lie in unincorporated King County.

Upon receipt of the maps it was determined that the portions of unincorporated King County within Seattle's service area are already served by sewer lines and that it would not be necessary to extend sewer lines in King County in order to serve those areas within Seattle's sewer service area.

It was further determined that the lack of a King County approved Seattle Comprehensive Sewer System Plan has caused problems for persons wishing to connect to the sewer lines that are adjacent to their property. It is in the interest of public health, safety, and welfare to encourage people to connect to nearby sewer lines rather than forcing them to put in on-site sewage disposal systems.

On May 15, 1984, the Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC) recommended approval of the City of Seattle's 1980 Sewage Collection System Modifications 201 Facility Plan.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Seattle's 1980 Sewage Collection System Modifications 201 Facility Plan as adopted by City Resolution No. 26378 is hereby approved.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 16th day of July, 1984.
