

ORDINANCE NO. 6878

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$13,800 from special programs, executive contingency to civil service for costs relating to Sergeant examinations and appropriating \$4,000 from special programs, executive contingency to the Division of Personnel to cover costs related to a clerical classification study, and amending Ordinance 6597, Sections 16, 23, and 34, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$13,800 to civil service from special programs, executive contingency for costs relating to Sergeant examinations.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 6597, Section 16, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Civil Service ((~~\$127,081~~)) \$153,056

The maximum number of FTE's to be budgeted for civil service shall be: 2.00

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 6597, Section 23, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Personnel ((~~\$969,559~~)) \$974,559

The maximum number of FTE's to be budgeted for personnel shall be 25.00

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 6597, Section 34, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Special Programs ((~~\$2,554,526~~)) \$2,536,726

Provided that:

1. Up to \$239,676 is reserved in the executive contingency for 18.8 positions (9.4 FTE's) to staff one residential floor in

1 the new jail, should inmate population levels require its use.

2 2. \$10,000 shall be used as a reward for information leading
3 to the identification and prosecution of the Green River murderer.

4 3. Alcoholism. \$181,042 shall be held in executive
5 contingency in special programs pending the development of a
6 revised division budget.
