

ORDINANCE NO. 6882

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$25,000 to CIP Project No. 002022, Superior Court Space, from special programs, executive contingency; and amending Ordinance No. 6597, Sections 34, 36, and 76, Attachment No. 1, as amended; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an amount of \$25,000 to CIP Project No. 002022, Superior Court Space, from special programs, executive contingency; for the purpose of conducting a management study of superior court space needs.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 6597, Section 34, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Special Programs	((\$2,528,551))	<u>\$2,503,551</u>
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Provided that:

1. Up to \$239,676 is reserved in the executive contingency for 18.8 positions (9.4 FTE's) to staff one residential floor in the new jail, should inmate population levels require its use.

2. \$10,000 shall be used as a reward for information leading to the identification and prosecution of the Green River murderer.

3. Alcoholism. \$181,042 shall be held in executive contingency in special programs pending the development of a revised division budget.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 6597, Section 36, is hereby amended to read as follows:
