ORDINANCE No. 6895

AN ORDINANCE defining the boundaries of the one acre site of the Dougherty Farmstead designated as a King County Landmark, and amending King County Ordinance 6691, Section 2.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6691, Section 2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The King County Council hereby designates the Dougherty Farmstead as described in Exhibit A a Community Landmark pursuant to King County Ordinance 4828, except for a one-acre parcel described in Exhibit ((A+2)) B, dated April 11, 1984, which is hereby designated a King County Landmark pursuant to King County Ordinance 4828.
