ORDINANCE NO. 6898

AN ORDINANCE granting conditional interim approval to Addendum No. 1 of the Summit Sewer District Coal Creek Service Area Preliminary Comprehensive Water Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On September 13, 1982 the Summit Sewer District Coal Creek Service Area Preliminary Comprehensive Water Plan was granted conditional interim approval by King County Ordinance.

During 1983, Summit Sewer District in conjunction with Kittitas County Sewer District No. 1 drilled and tested 2 wells in accordance with the interim approval granted the Coal Creek Service Area Preliminary Comprehensive Plan.

The wells were tested for both quality and quantity and it was determined that they would be a safer, more reliable source of water for the Summit Sewer District Water System.

On September 13, 1983 the approval granted to the Summit Sewer District Coal Creek Service Area Preliminary Comprehensive Water Plan expired.

In the interest of public health, safety and welfare, Summit Sewer District, in conjunction with Kittitas County Sewer District No. 1, desires to connect the well sources to their distribution system and abandon the surface source they are currently using.

On May 22, 1984 by Resolution No. 84-2 Summit Sewer District adopted Addendum No. 1.

On May 22, 1984 by Resolution No. 84-6 Kittitas Sewer District No. 1 adopted Addendum No. 1 and authorized the sale of bonds to cover construction costs.

On June 5, 1984 and June 19, 1984 The Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC) reviewed Addendum No. 1 of the Summit Sewer District Coal Creek Service Area Preliminary Comprehensive Water Plan.

The UTRC further determined that Snoqualmie summit is possessed of a very short construction season in which water system improvements may be made.

On June 19, 1984, the UTRC recommended that the water system improvements proposed in Addendum No. 1 of the Summit Sewer District Coal Creek Service Area Preliminary Comprehensive Water Plan be granted conditional interim approval.

On June 19, 1984, Summit Sewer District in conjunction with Kittitas County Sewer District No. 1, completed its submittal pursuant to RCW 57.16 and KCC 13.24.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Addendum No. 1 to the Summit Sewer District Coal Creek Service Area Preliminary Comprehensive Plan is granted interim approval until June 19, 1985, PROVIDED that:

- A. system improvements described in Addendum No. 1 that are not constructed in 1984 are not approved unless an updated and revised comprehensive plan is prepared and submitted to King County for approval; and
- B. such a comprehensive plan shall consist of a single independent document and shall not be addenda to older plans.

SECTION 2. This interim approval shall not be construed to imply approval of the development of a pass-wide system without the preparation and submittal of an appropriate comprehensive plan pursuant to RCW 57.16 and KCC 13.24.
