AN ORDINANCE approving Amendment No. 1 to the Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District Comprehensive Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On February 20, 1984, Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District passed Resolution No. 84-2-17 amending the comprehensive water system plan.

On July 2, 1984, Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed comprehensive water system plan amendment.

On July 3, 1984, Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District completed its submittal of Amendment No. 1 to its comprehensive water system plan, pursuant to RCW 57.16 and KCC 13.24.

On July 3, 1984, the Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC) reviewed Amendment No. 1 to the Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District and recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Amendment No. 1 to the Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District Comprehensive Water System Plan as adopted by district Resolution No. 84-2-17 is hereby approved.
