

ORDINANCE NO. 3972

AN ORDINANCE relating to the closure of portions of the following public streets; 19th Avenue South, 20th Avenue South, 21st Avenue South, 22nd Avenue South, 23rd Avenue South, South 138th Street and South 140th Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A. Barricades shall be installed by the department of public works to prevent vehicular use of the following streets:

1. 19th Avenue South, south of South 136th Street and north of South 140th
2. 20th Avenue South, south of South 136th Street and north of South 140th
3. 21st Avenue South, south of South 136th Street and north of South 140th
4. 22nd Avenue South, south of South 136th Street and north of South 140th
5. 23rd Avenue South, south of South 136th Street and north of South 140th
6. South 138th Street, east of 18th Avenue South and west of 24th Avenue South.
7. South 140th Street, east of 18th Avenue and west of 24th Avenue South.

B. The streets listed above in paragraph A shall be closed to all vehicular traffic, except fire, police or other emergency equipment, until further notice.

C. Public notice of these street closures shall conform to the requirements of RCW 47.48.020.
