

ORDINANCE NO. 6999

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Annexation 28 to King County Water District No. 108.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Annexation 28 to King County Water District No. 108 was filed with the county council effective October 8, 1984.

2. King County Water District No. 108 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 2008 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 108 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated August 20, 1984, on the proposed annexation.

4. The county council held a public hearing on the 5th day of November, 19 84 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 108 of the area known as Annexation 28 and described in Section 4 herein is approved for water service only. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 57.02.040 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Annexation 28.

SECTION 2. King County Water District No. 108 is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

1        SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute  
2 county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifica-  
3 tions, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation  
4 area.

5        SECTION 4. The area known as Annexation 28 to be annexed is  
6 described as follows:

7            Portion of the NW 1/4 of Section 21, Township 22 North,  
8            Range 6 East, W.M., described as follows:

9            The N 1/2 of the S 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of  
10           Section 21-22-6;

11           together with

12           The N 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Section 21  
13           lying west of the SW margin of the R/W of the abandoned  
14           Burlington Northern Railroad;

15           together with

16           The E 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said  
17           Section 21;

18           together with

19           The NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of  
20           said Section 21.
