AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of Alley in the Plat of Eastside Addition to Tacoma Petitioner: Calvin King and Others V-1838

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

- A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of alley in the plat of Eastside Addition to Tacoma, hereinafter described.
- The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements were not required.
- 3. The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the prinicples and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of Eastside Addition to Tacoma recorded November 20, 1889 in Volume 4 of Plats, page 46, records of King County, Washington. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is therefore classified "Class C" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County council on the day of Sulphon, 1984.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The council, on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of Icentee , 19 thereby vacates and abandons the portion of alley in the plat of Eastside Addition to Tacoma, described as follows:

> Vacate all that portion of entire alley of Block 12, Eastside Addition to Tacoma lying South of the Southerly right of way margin

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of S.W. 364th Street and Northeasterly of tax parcel 218000-1392-0. Situated in King County, Washington. The vacation area contains 6,800 Sq. Ft., M/L. INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 8th day of October, 19<u>84</u>. PASSED on this 31d day of December , 19**84** .
