

ORDINANCE NO. 77051

1 AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation
2 of \$4,950 to Sewer & Drainage 3 Bond, Fund 7179,
3 from the Sewer & Drainage 3 Maintenance Fund No.
4 3101; and amending Ordinance No. 6597, Section 72,
5 as amended.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a
8 supplemental appropriation of \$4,950 to Sewer & Drainage 3 Bond,
9 Fund 7179 from the fund balance of Sewer & Drainage 3 Maintenance
10 Fund.

11 SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 6597, Section 72, is hereby amended
12 to read as follows:

13 From the following named debt service funds, there are hereby
14 appropriated the amounts hereinafter specified for the payment of
15 principal and interest on the several general obligation bond
16 issues authorized by vote and/or by virtue of the authority of
17 the board of county commissioners or county council:

18 Limited GO Bond Redemption	\$ 8,399,385
19 Unlimited GO Bond Redemption	\$18,041,740
20 Stadium Limited Bond Redemption	\$ 814,630
21 Stadium Unlimited Bond Redemption	\$ 2,605,700
22 <u>Sewer & Drainage 3 Bond</u>	<u>\$ 4,950</u>

2 The county executive shall provide to the chairman of the
3 county council fiscal management committee all documents and
4 information received from bond counsel and financial advisors
5 regarding the advance refunding of county general obligation
6 bonds as proposed in Executive Budget Position Paper 30.

7 In order that county council staff will have sufficient time
8 to review the proposed refunding and to advise the council on the
9 matter, such information and documents shall be provided
10 immediately upon receipt by the executive.
