AN ORDINANCE approving the Water District No. 81
Rose Hill Water and Sewer District Comprehensive
Sewer Plan

PREAMBLE:

On July 3, 1984, Water District No. 81 adopted a Declara-
tion of Non-Significance for the Sewer Comprehensive Plan.

On July 24, 1984, Water District No. 81 passed resolution
494, adopting the Rose Hill Comprehensive Sewer Plan.

On August 20, 1984, Water District No. 81 submitted the
Comprehensive Sewer Plan to the Utilities Technical Review
Committee, as required by KCC 13.24 and RCW 56.08.

On September 4, 1984, the Utilities Technical Review
Committee reviewed the proposed Comprehensive Sewer Plan and
recommended conditional approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Water District No. 81, Rose Hill Water and
Sewer District Comprehensive Sewer Plan dated 1984, is hereby
approved; PROVIDED the county divests itself of the Trend County
Sewer Service Area, as part of its overall divestiture of King
County Sewer Systems, and Water District 81 signs an interlocal
agreement with the City of Kirkland regarding service areas.


This approval shall be effective as of the date the Trend


