

ORDINANCE NO. 7091

AN ORDINANCE relating to levying the property taxes of King County for the year 1985.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 7066, Section 2, is amended to read as follows:

The Council of King County, Washington, finds that the levies necessary to fund estimated expenditures for the year 1985, less the total of estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including available surplus and such expenditures as are to be met from bond warrant issues, be and the same are hereby fixed as follows:
