

ORDINANCE NO. 7120

AN ORDINANCE relating to the plumbing advisory board, repealing Ordinance No. 6746, Section 18 and KCC 16.32.160 and adding a substitute section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6746, Section 18 and K.C.C. 16.32.160 are each hereby repealed, and the following is substituted:

Plumbing advisory board. A. The King County executive is authorized to execute an interlocal agreement with the City of Seattle to provide for the creation and operation of a joint city-county plumbing advisory board. The following persons shall be ex-officio members of the board: the chief of environmental health, the manager, King County building and land development division, the director of the City of Seattle department of construction and land use, and the Seattle superintendent of water.

B. The interlocal agreement shall establish a procedure for the mayor of the City of Seattle and the King County executive each to appoint an equal number of additional board members. Appointments by the executive shall be subject to confirmation by a majority of the county council. The eight appointed members shall be representative of one each of the following: journeyman plumbers, plumbing contractors, building construction industry, architects, professional mechanical engineers, sanitary engineers, real estate management and the public.

1 The King County executive shall appoint two members and the  
2 mayor of the City of Seattle one member to a term ending  
3 December 31, 1985, the King County executive shall appoint one  
4 member and the mayor of the City of Seattle shall appoint two  
5 members to a term ending December 31, 1986, and the mayor of  
6 the City of Seattle and the King County executive shall each  
7 appoint one member to terms ending December 31, 1987.

8 Thereafter such members shall be appointed to a term of three  
9 years ending December 31 of the third year of said term.

10 C. The plumbing code advisory board shall elect a chairman  
11 who shall serve at the pleasure of the members. Such board may  
12 adopt rules of procedure and shall meet on call, subject to  
13 timely notice.

14 D. The plumbing code advisory board may examine rulings,  
15 or proposed rulings, of the administrative authority related to  
16 this code, and may hold hearings and make recommendations to  
17 the administrative authority, and to the King County executive  
18 and King County council, but it shall act in an advisory  
19 capacity only.
