ORDINANCE NO. 7184

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of  
an area known as Carey Place to King  
County Water District No. 42.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Carey Place to King County Water District No. 42 was filed with the county council effective March 22, 1985.

2. King County Water District No. 42 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by (Resolution No. 84-16 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 42 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated February 4, 1985, on the proposed annexation.

4. The county council held a public hearing on the 22nd day of April, 1985 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 42 of the area known as Carey Place and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 57.02.040 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Carey Place.

SECTION 2. King County Water District No. 42 is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

1            SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute  
2 county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifica-  
3 tions, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation  
4 area.

5            SECTION 4. The area known as Carey Place to be annexed is  
6 described as follows:

7            Portion of Lot 28, Echo Lake Garden Tracts 5th Division  
8 as recorded in Vol 12 of plats pg 28, and a portion of  
9 5th Avenue N.E. right-of-way, described as follows:

10           PORTION WESTERLY OF CENTERLINE OF 5TH AVENUE N.E.  
11           RIGHT-OF WAY AND EASTERLY OF A LINE BEGINNING AT A  
12           POINT ON THE SOUTH LINE 255.802 FEET WEST OF THE  
13           SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SAID LOT; THENCE N00°49'36"W  
14           92.00 FEET; THENCE N04°52'54" E 70.00 FEET; THENCE  
15           N89°02'51"W 68.103 FEET; THENCE N00°49'36"W 135.74  
16           FEET TO NORTH LINE. LESS SOUTHERLY 80.00 feet of the  
17           east 180.00 FEET.
