ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as BONDO to King County Water District No. 104.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as BONDO to King County Water District No. 104 was filed with the county council effective March 12, 1985.

2. King County Water District No. 104 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 1850 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 104 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated February 26, 1985, on the proposed annexation.

4. The county council held a public hearing on the 22nd day of April, 19 85 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 104 of the area known as BONDO and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 57.02.040 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on BONDO.

SECTION 2. King County Water District No. 104 is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

The East half of the Northwest quarter of Section 21, Township 26 North, Range 6 East, W.M., King County, Washington; LESS the South 660.00 feet thereof.




