ORDINANCE NO. 7227

AN ORDINANCE amending permit fees for retail sales and public display of fireworks, and amending Ordinance No. 7024.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 7024, Section 3 is hereby amended as follows:

Each permit issued by the King County fire marshal under authority of the Uniform Fire Code shall be subject to the following annual fee schedule:
