AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Renton
Comprehensive Sewer Plan

PREAMBLE:

On May 28, 1984, the City of Renton issued a Declaration of Non-significance for the city's Comprehensive Sewer Plan.

On June 11, 1984, the City of Renton City Council passed resolution no. 2546, adopting the Comprehensive Sewer Plan for the city.

On July 11, 1984, the City of Renton Comprehensive Sewer Plan was submitted to King County for review pursuant to RCW 56.08 and KCC 13.24.

On August 7, 1984, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed plan and recommended a conditional approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Renton Comprehensive Sewer Plan, dated 1984, is approved; PROVIDED that the Honey Creek Interceptor is constructed in accordance with King County Standards, and that sewer service will not be extended outside of the Local Service Area as designated in the Sewerage General Plan. King County approval of the city's sewer plan does not constitute county approval of the METRO proposed May Creek Interceptor.

PROVIDED further, that the sewer service within the Central Planning Area shall not include any area for which a developer extension contract for sewer service has been approved with and
