ORDINANCE NO. 7252

AN ORDINANCE conditionally approving the Water District 128 1985 Comprehensive Sewer Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On March 11, 1985 the Board of Commissioners of Water District 128 issued a Declaration of Non-Significance for the District's Comprehensive Sewer Plan.

On April 22, 1985 the Board of Commissioners of Water District 128 passed Resolution No. 85-5, adopting the Comprehensive Sewer Plan for the district.

On May 7, 1985 and May 21, 1985 the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed plan and recommended conditional approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Water District 128 1985 Comprehensive Sewer Plan, is approved; PROVIDED that,

A. King County divest itself of the Olson and Skyway Sewer Districts as part of its overall divestiture of King County Sewer Systems, and

B. This approval shall be effective as of the final date the Olson and Skyway Sewer District divestitures are complete.
