ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE relating to traffic, setting the speed limit at 25 mph for South 200th Street from Military Road South to Pacific Highway South (SR 99).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The maximum speed limit for South 200th Street from Military Road South to Pacific Highway South (SR 99) is hereby set at 25 miles per hour until a signal light is installed at 32nd Avenue South and South 200th Street.

SECTION 2. The department of public works shall post signs to evidence the above described speed limit upon the effective date of this ordinance.
