ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE relating to regulation of hours of use of county property known as 37th Avenue South, north of South Star Lake Road, prescribing penalties, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Public use of the publicly owned property known as 37th Avenue South, north of South Star Lake Road, between South Star Lake Road and Star Lake is prohibited between 10 P.M. and 6 A.M. daily.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to consume alcoholic beverages within the publicly owned property known as 37th Avenue South between South Star Lake Road and Star Lake.

SECTION 3. Signs to evidence the above described restrictions shall be immediately installed by the proper authority.

SECTION 4. Any violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor and is punishable, upon conviction by a fine not exceeding two hundred and fifty dollars or by confinement in the county jail for a period not exceeding ninety days, or both.

SECTION 5. Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
