

ORDINANCE NO. **7270**

1 AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning
2 and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution
3 No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the
4 application of SAMUEL McCROSKY, MARY SPARKS AND ALLIN JOHNSON,
5 designated Building and Land Development File No. 217-85-R.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and
8 conclusions of the June 21, 1985 report of the zoning and subdivision examiner,
9 filed with the clerk of the council on July 11, 1985 on the application of
10 Samuel McCrosky, Mary Sparks and Allin Johnson to reclassify certain property
11 described in building and land development file no. 217-85-R.

12 SECTION 2. The recommendation by the zoning and subdivision examiner to
13 reclassify the subject property from SR (Potential BC), BC-P, CG-P and SR
14 (Potential RM 2400) to BC-P in lieu of BC, subject to conditions, is hereby
15 adopted by the council of King County. Those conditions, if any which must be
16 satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one
17 year of council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall
18 be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date shall be ten
19 days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the building
20 and land development division shall amend the official zoning maps of King
21 County to reflect this action.
