ORDINANCE NO. 7331

AN ORDINANCE approving The Woodland Heights Comprehensive Water Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On August 16, 1984, the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services approved the Woodland Heights Water System.

On April 16, 1985, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the Woodland Heights Water Comprehensive Plan.

On June 4, 1985, the Utilities Technical Review Committee recommended approval of the Woodland Heights Water Comprehensive Plan, with the proviso that the developers notify all new lot purchasers that they are subject to the costs of upgrading to Water District No. 104's Standards.

The Woodland Heights Water Comprehensive Plan is Categoricaly Exempt from the State Environmental Policy Act Under WAC 197-11-800 (20) and (22)b.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Woodland Heights Water Association Comprehensive Water Plan is hereby approved, provided that the owner of each lot served by this system shall give notice to each purchaser that they are subject to the costs of upgrading the water system to meet Water District No. 104's Standards
