

ORDINANCE NO. 7392

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$2,500 from the Executive Contingency to help fund a study to determine the need for an International Trade Center in Seattle-King County, amending Ordinance No. 7027, Sections 37 and 82, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$2,500 from the Executive Contingency per Motion 6300, adopted by the King County council July 1, 1985, to help fund a Seattle Chamber of Commerce study to determine the need for an International Trade Center in Seattle-King County and its specific functions.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 7027, Section 37, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

SPECIAL PROGRAMS - From the Current Expense Fund (Executive Contingency) additional funds are hereby appropriated to:

Special Programs \$2,500

Provided that:

Transfer of these funds to the Seattle Chamber of Commerce is contingent upon the execution of a performance contract between the Chamber and the county stipulating the services to be received by the county in exchange for these funds.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 7027, Section 82, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
