

ORDINANCE NO. 17409

1 AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the  
2 Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County  
3 Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying  
4 certain property upon the application of Laurence  
5 Stromme, designated Building and Land Development  
6 Division File No. 123-85-R.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and  
9 conclusions of the October 29, 1985 report of the zoning and subdivision  
10 examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on November 14, 1985 on the  
11 application of Laurence Stromme to reclassify certain property described in  
12 building and land development file no. 123-85-R.

13 SECTION 2. The recommendation of the zoning and subdivision examiner  
14 to reclassify the subject property from RS 7200 (Potential RT 2400) to RT  
15 2400-P subject to conditions (modified) is hereby adopted by the council of  
16 King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this  
17 ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of council  
18 approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this  
19 ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective  
20 date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming  
21 effective, the building and land development division shall amend the  
22 official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
