

ORDINANCE NO. 7417

AN ORDINANCE changing the rate of the excise tax on the use of all telephone access lines in King County as approved by the voters of King County in November, 1981 for the purpose of paying for the implementation and operation of an enhanced 911 emergency telephone system, establishing the effective date of the tax, and amending Ordinance 6875, Sections 2 and 6.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6875, Section 2, is hereby amended to read as follows: The rate of the tax imposed by Section 1 shall be ((~~forty-five~~)) thirty cents per month per telephone access line.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 6875, Section 6, is hereby amended to read as follows: The tax imposed by this ordinance shall be effective from and after ((~~September-27-1984~~)) January 1, 1986.
